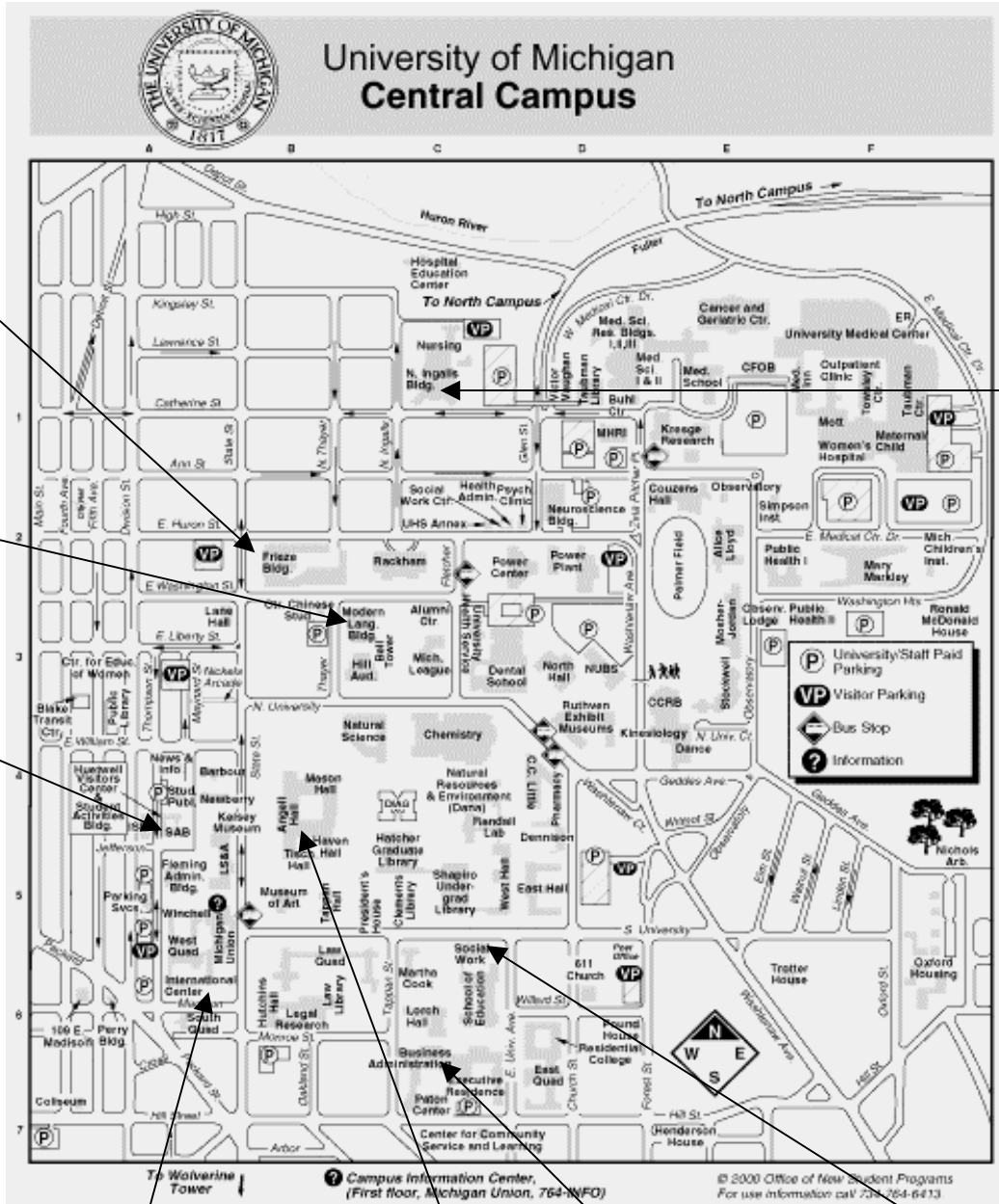


# Map of International Resources at the University of Michigan for Undergraduates

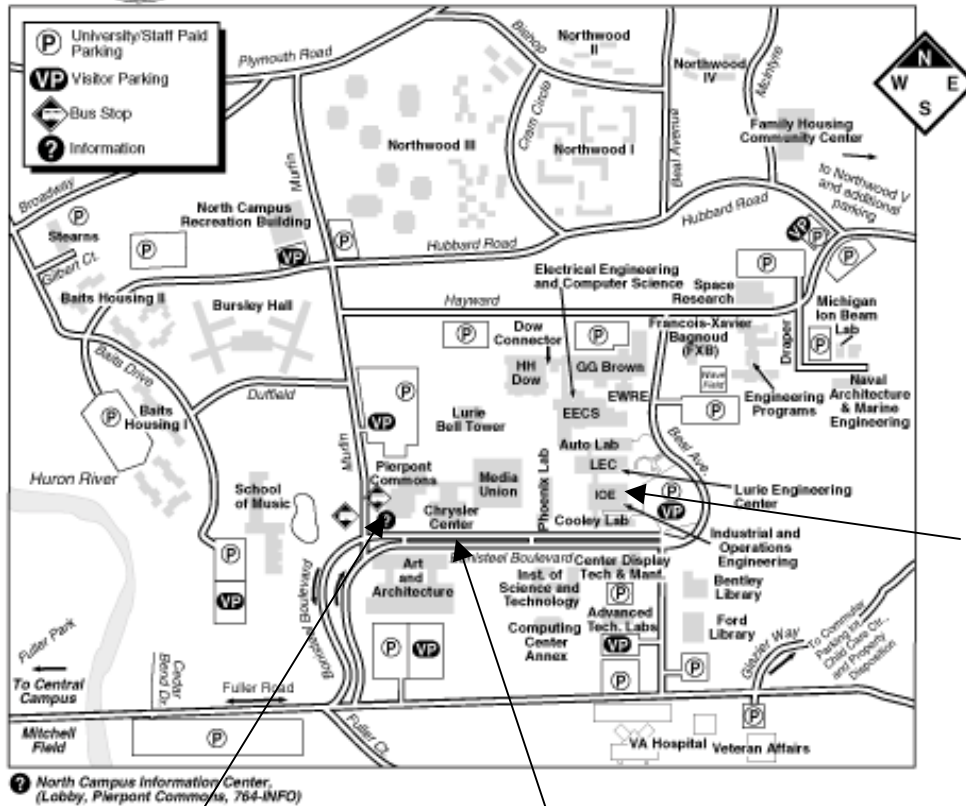
